5. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON INSTITUTING A VOUCHER SYSTEM FOR THE CITY DUMPSTER.

Our District Rep told Jerry that it's not unusual for towns our size to have problems with their dumpster and that we become a dump for the county. He said if we don't get it under control we'll have it full in 2-3 days and have to set there with it full before we can get it dumped. We have 10 free dumps a year and every time after that is about \$600 each time. He recommends some sort of voucher system or to keep it locked up with a key and close it on weekends and no trailers.

Tyler asked who would have the Key. Jerry said Bruce will have one at the City Barn.

We could let people dump 2 truckloads/year free and after that every truck load is \$25.

Abigail said she can put together a spreadsheet to keep track of how many times people use it and have it for the council to look at next month.

6. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON CHANGING THE PRICE OF A 2 YARD DUMPSTER TO \$40.

Utility Clerk, Kim Wilson stated that we currently charge \$33.53 for a 2 yard dumpster when most towns are charging \$50. She believes that we need to up our price at least to \$40 to keep up with our raising trash bill.

Bessie said that if we raise the price she's sending hers back.

Some council members spoke about the possibility keeping the price the same until January 1, 2021 or grandfathering in the people who currently have a 2 yard.

Kenneth made a motion to raise the price of a 2 yard dumpster to \$40 beginning March 1, 2020. Tyler seconded.
